Students live in sections of Westmont, Clarendon Hills, and Downers Grove.</p>	<p><u>Organization of School Year</u></p> <p>The school year consists of four quarters, each nine weeks long. The day is divided into seven 50-minute periods. The first semester ends on December 18, 2020, and the second semester ends on May 26, 2021.</p>
<p><u>School</u></p> <p>The Fall 2020 enrollment at Westmont High School is 372 students, with 92 students in the Class of 2021.
