In this agreement, “we”, “us”, & “our” means Community Unit School District 201. “You” & “your” means the parent/guardian & the student enrolled in CUSD 201. The “property” is the Chromebook owned by CUSD 201. Upon signing this agreement, you are eligible to receive the property at no cost with the following terms and conditions:

<b>Terms</b> <b>P:</b> <b>S:</b>	You will comply at all times with the CUSD 201 Code of Conduct & Acceptable Use Agreement. Any failure to comply may terminate your rights of possession effective immediately & the school may repossess the property. Chromebooks are assigned to a single individual and are not shared.
<b>Title</b> <b>P:</b> <b>S:</b>	Legal title to the property is held by CUSD 201 at all times. Your right of possession & use is limited to & Title conditioned upon your full and complete compliance with the Chromebook Policy Handbook and the CUSD 201 Acceptable Use Policy. Filtering software is installed on all District devices, but no filtering software is perfect. Your compliance with this agreement may also require parental and self-monitoring while outside CUSD 201 facilities.
<b>Loss/Damage</b> <b>P:</b> <b>S:</b>	Loss or theft of the property must be reported to school administration by the next school day following occurrence. You may be required to file a police report. If the property is accidentally damaged, CUSD 201 will assess the Chromebook damage and repair or replace the device under the accidental loss or damage policy. If a determination is made that the damage is caused intentionally or maliciously, the district may determine that you are fully liable for the cost of repair or replacement.
<b>Terms of Agreement</b> <b>P:</b> <b>S:</b>	If you do not fully comply with all terms of this Agreement and the Acceptable Use Agreement including the timely return of the property, CUSD 201 shall be entitled to declare you in default and require a return of the device or its replacement value. Your right to use and retain possession of the property terminates no later than the last day of the 2023/2024 school year, unless prior arrangements have been made with the school principal (ie summer school)..
<b>Appropriation</b> <b>P:</b> <b>S:</b>	Your failure to return the property in a timely manner and the continued use of it for non-school purposes without the consent of CUSD 201 may be considered unlawful appropriation of the school's property.

## CUSD 201 Chromebook Protection Plan Agreement

As part of the one-to-one program, a \$32 non-refundable deposit is required to participate in the CUSD 201 Chromebook Protection Plan. Enrollment in the Plan allows for a simple fee schedule to be applied to breakage or damage that is ineligible for warranty repair with the manufacturer. Covered breakage and damage includes accidental damage (drops/spills), loss, theft, vandalism, fire, flood, and natural disasters whether occurring on or off school grounds. The AC power cord nor the carrying case are NOT covered in this protection plan. If the deposit to the protection plan is not paid, parents assume full financial responsibility for repair or replacement.

Non-refundable deposit for the Chromebook Protection Plan: \$32 per year (August 17, 2023 – May 24, 2024). The deposit is not refundable unless your child leaves within 10 days of the start of school.

Deductible to be paid per incident over and above a \$32 per year deposit

Repair (no need to replace Chromebook)	\$25 for the first incident; \$50 for subsequent incidences
Replacement due to irreparable damage/stolen/lost	\$75 for the first incident; \$100 for subsequent incidences
